

657118 Sizzix® Bigz™ Die – Flowers, 3-D #2 by Eileen Hull



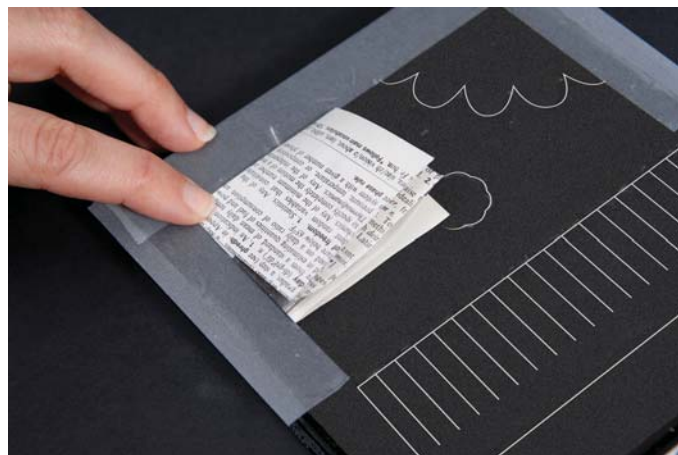
1. Prepare the die by masking off the edge of the die with single-sided tape.



2. Tape should be aligned so that it comes right up to the edge of the Flower patterns.



3. Cut material of choice into 4" squares and fold it twice so that it is folded into quarters.



4. Die-cut the folded material by placing the closed corner against the tape mask while the open folds face toward the center of the die.



5. Build your sandwich as you would any other Bigz die. Depending on the thickness of your material, you may cut several layers and both Flowers at one time.



6. These are the basic building blocks and can be used in several different ways to build a variety of Flowers.

7. To build pom-pom style Flowers, leave the petals folded and punch a small hole in the corner of each.



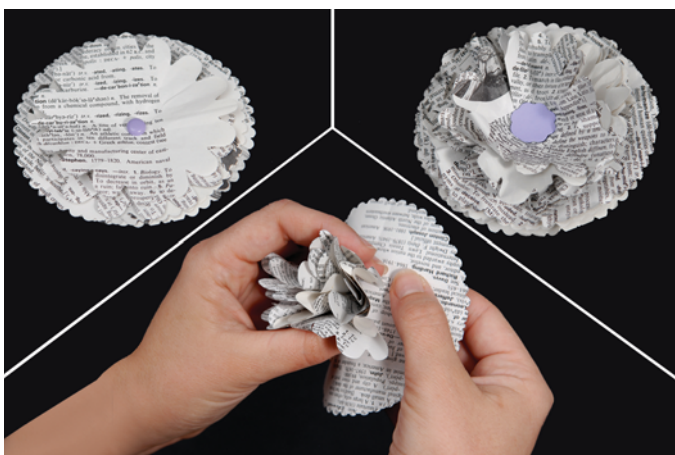
8. String the petals together using a needle and thread.



9. Turn the Flower over and evenly distribute the petals.



10. Scrunch the petals to create desired volume.



11. Petals may also be used unfolded to create many different and unique blossoms. Experiment!



12. To create a fringe-style Flower, die-cut and apply adhesive to desired number of fringe pieces.

13. Wrap the fringe strip or strips around the top of a dowel or skewer.



14. Arrange the fringe pieces to create the desired volume. The above example is a Flower built with two fringe strips. You may use floral tape or paper to cover the Flower base and stem.
